Instructions to Voter

- To vote, darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.
- Note the permitted number of choices directly below each office title.
- Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed. If you do, that contest or question will not be counted.
- To vote for a write-in candidate: darken the oval (●) to the left of the blank line and write in the candidate's name.
- Only votes cast for candidates who filed as write-in candidates can be counted.
- Do not write in a candidate's name if their name is already printed on the ballot for that same contest.
- If you make a mistake or want to change your vote, return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot.
- You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.
