Subject **A Resolution establishing the View and First Hearing for the proposed Roose Ditch Improvement Petition.**

Commissioner Smith moved for the adoption of the following Resolution which was seconded by Commissioner Clighton:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Revised Code § 6131.07, this Board has received notice of the filing of a petition for a ditch improvement under Revised Code Chapter 6131, styled as the Roose Ditch Improvement including a list of owners of parcels of land averred by the petitioner to be benefitted or damaged by the construction of the proposed improvement; and

WHEREAS, Revised Code § 6131.07 requires this Board to fix a date and hour for the view of the proposed improvement together with a subsequent date, hour, and place upon which to hold its first hearing on the improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the date and time fixed for the view the proposed ditch improvement shall be:

IN THE MATTER OF: ROOSE DITCH IMPROVEMENT PETITION

NOTICE OF VIEWING AND HEARING OF PROPOSED DITCH IMPROVEMENT

There has been filed with the board of county commissioners of Stark County, Ohio, a petition under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6131 for a ditch improvement known as the Roose ditch improvement.

You are receiving this notice of viewing and hearing of the proposed ditch improvement because you have been identified as the owner of land encompassed within the described course and termini of the proposed improvement.

The petition generally avers that the Roose ditch is inadequate to accommodate or control drainage from the watershed. The petition further avers that the improvement is necessary, will benefit the petitioners, and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The petition requests the board of county commissioners to take steps to clean, remove obstructions, deepen the ditch and lower the culvert under the iron horse trail.

All costs of engineering, construction, and future maintenance will be assessed to the benefiting parcels of land.

The viewing will be conducted by the board of commissioners and the county engineer. You are welcome to attend the view of the proposed improvement. The purpose of the view is to apprise the board of the scope and nature of the proposed improvement. You are also welcome to attend the first hearing at which you may offer evidence for or against the granting of the proposed improvement. Following the first hearing, the board will deliberate and determine findings either for or against the proposed improvement.
