Type 2 Hazmat Team Capabilities (in accordance with NIMS):

- Respond to Known and Unknown Chemical Releases
- Identify and Mitigate Chemical Releases
- Ability to detect the presence of known gases or vapors, oxygen deficiency percentage, flammable atmosphere lower explosive limit (LEL), carbon monoxide, hydrogen sulfide, and other specific detection capabilities
- Ability to sample, collect, containerize, label, and prepare to transport known and unknown toxic industrial chemicals or toxic industrial materials – both liquid and solid – to include samples used as evidence
- Ability to detect and survey for alpha, beta, and gamma radiation, and identify isotopes



Hazmat Technician Initial Requirements:

- Hazmat Technician Course
- Physical Health Assessment
- Mask Fit Test (Respirator Fit Test)

Annual Training After Acceptance:

- Physical Health or Fit For Duty Assessment
- Emergency Vehicle Operations Course
- Hazmat Technician Refresher
- One (1) "Drill"
- 24 Hours of Training
